

The first column "Handler" indicates the highest class a handler has competed in.
 The second column "Dog" indicates the highest class a dog has competed in.
 The third column "Class" indicates the class handler may want to enter the dog in.
 The fourth column "Compete for Points" indicates if this team is eligible in that Class to compete for VBCA year end award points.

The three wins rule: If a handler is running a dog in a lower class than it was previously run, once it has three wins, it is no longer eligible to accumulate VBCA year end points, but keeps points that have accumulated up to and including the third win in that class. The handler may chose to keep this dog in that class for the remainder of the year without accumulating any additional points toward the VBCA end of year points or may move the dog up to the next level and compete for VBCA end of year points.

When a handler purchases a dog that has competed in the USBCHA Nursery Finals, this dog will be classified as an Open Ranch level dog. If owner/trainer keeps dog after competing in USBCHA Nursery Finals, he/she may finish the year in class run previous to finals.
